### JUNE DISPLAYS

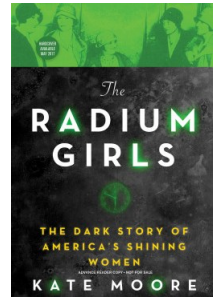
